In February 2022, the City, in collaboration with regional governmental entities, leaders from businesses, large and small, and representatives from a variety of industries throughout the Southland, introduced the Regional Alliance Marketplace for Procurement (RAMP).

RAMP will replace the City's Business Assistance Virtual Network (LABAVN) and offer a wider variety of features including contracting opportunities from various agencies and municipalities, expanded vendor profiles, self-attested business information, and automated outreach for City certifications. Current LABAVN users who have an <u>Angeleno</u>-connected LABAVN accounts will automatically be migrated to RAMP.
