

**CIRCULATING PETITIONS:** Circulators of Nominating Petitions shall be at least 18 years of age [Election Code §307(f)].

**VALID SIGNATURES - WHERE OBTAINED:**

From qualified, registered voters of Board District 5 of the Los Angeles Unified School District [Charter §422(a)].

**FILING PETITIONS\*:** Write-In Petitions must be filed at the Election Division office beginning Monday, January 7 through Tuesday, February 19, 2019, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. All sections of the Petition must be filed at the same time [Election Code Sections 111(b) and 310(a)].

**SUPPLEMENTAL PETITIONS:** If the Petition is found to be insufficient prior to the deadline for filing Petitions, a Supplemental Petition may be filed. These Petitions must be obtained from the Election Division. No Supplemental Petitions are accepted for filing after the last day specified for filing Write-In Petitions – Tuesday, February 19, 2019 [Charter Section 422(c) and Election Code Section 310(j)].

**CAMPAIGN FINANCE REQUIREMENTS  
Board of Education Candidates and Committees**

Candidates and committees are required to disclose financial information to the public by filing a Statement of Economic Interests (State Form 700), a Recipient Committee Campaign Statement (State Form 460), in addition to other required forms. These forms must be filed with the Los Angeles City Ethics Commission, which serves as the filing officer for all campaign disclosure filings.

Candidates and committees are also subject to other campaign finance laws, such as requirements regarding political communications. Candidate fundraising cannot begin until filing a Declaration of Intent to Solicit & Receive Contributions (State Form 12).

**STATE FORM 700  
STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC INTERESTS**

All Write-In candidates must file a State Form 700 with the Ethics Commission. The form itemizes personal financial interests, including investments, interests in real property held by the candidate on the date of filing, and sources of income received during the 12 months prior to the date of filing.

First day to apply for and vote a Vote-By-Mail ballot for the Special Election.

**FEBRUARY 19, TUESDAY\***

Last day to file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Write-In Candidate or to withdraw said declaration.

Last day to register to vote in the Special Election.

**FEBRUARY 26, MONDAY**

Last day to apply by mail for a Vote-By-Mail ballot for the Special Election.

**MARCH 5, 2019 TUESDAY – ELECTION DAY**

Last day to vote a Vote-By-Mail ballot in the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's Office for the Special Election.

**APRIL 4, THURSDAY**

Last day for official canvass and certification of results for Special Election.

**APRIL 15, MONDAY**

First day to apply for and vote a Vote-By-Mail ballot for the Special Runoff Election.

**APRIL 29, MONDAY**

Last day to register to vote in the Special Runoff Election.

**MAY 7, TUESDAY**

Last day to apply by mail for a Vote-By-Mail ballot for the Special Runoff Election.

**MAY 14, 2019, TUESDAY – ELECTION DAY**

Last day to vote a Vote-By-Mail ballot in the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's Office for the Special Election.

**JUNE 13, THURSDAY**

Last day for official canvass and certification of results for Special Runoff Election.

**TERM OF OFFICE:** To fill unexpired term ending December 13, 2020.

**SALARY:** \$2,000 per month for each member who actually attends all meetings [Education Code§ 35120].

or

For a Board Member who devotes his or her entire time to the duties of serving as a member of the Board of Education for the LAUSD and who receives no compensation, fee, or honorarium from any other source, shall be paid a full time salary of \$125,000.<sup>1</sup>

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Registered voter of Los Angeles Unified School District at the time of nomination and election, and resident of the Fifth Board District since at least October 6, 2018 [Charter §407(a) and 803].

### DECLARATION OF INTENTION

To become a Write-In Candidate you must complete a Declaration of Intention to Become a Write-In Candidate form, which is furnished by the City Clerk. This is done in the Election Division on the following dates:

First Day – *Monday, January 7, 2019*

Last Day – *Tuesday, February 19, 2019*

**Please note:** The office will be closed on Monday, January 21, in observance of the Martin Luther King Holiday and Monday, February 18 in observance of the Presidents' Day Holiday.

**SIGNATURES AND FILING FEE** - Each Write-In Candidate shall do one of the following at the time they file their Declaration of Intention:

1. Pay a filing fee in the amount of \$300;  
or
2. File a Petition for Nomination on the form provided by the City Clerk bearing the signatures of no less than 500 and no more than 1,000 petitioners (500 signatures must be valid) in lieu of the filing fee.

The Nominating Petition, specifically for use by Write-In Candidates, must be obtained in advance from the Office of the City Clerk. Unused petition forms from previous filings may not be used.

Petitions are issued only to you or your representative. A representative must have your written and signed consent to receive them on your behalf.

### POLITICAL REFORM ACT OF 1974

The Political Reform Act of 1974 is a State of California statute that requires all candidates and committees supporting or opposing such candidates and committees, or supporting or opposing ballot measures in an election, to disclose their contributions and expenditures.
